The subject of Dr. Nurislamova's scientific interests are the issues of environmental optimisation, public health protection, hazard identification of chemical load of biological media and pathogenetic features of public health disorders under the influence of contamination, development of highly sensitive and selective methods of determination of exogenous compounds and elements in biospheres and food products, allowing to conduct research on risk assessment of anthropogenic impact of adverse environmental factors, its minimisation

Under her guidance and with her direct participation research is carried out in the department of chemical-analytical methods of research of the Centre for the development of methods for the determination of exogenous compounds in biospheres and environmental objects, developed methodological recommendations and manuals used in the current practical work of the Federal Service, and health care of the Perm region.

She is the author of more than 130 published scientific works, including 2 monographs, more than 60 methodological documents, 25 certificates of authorship and patents of the Russian Federation for inventions.
