Mark Sykes



Mark Sykes is the Head of Science for Fapas Proficiency Testing and is a Principal Scientist at Fera Science Ltd, UK. Mark has a degree in Chemistry from the University of York, UK, and a Masters Degree in Analytical Chemistry from the University of Huddersfield, UK. Mark started working at Fera (then called Central Science Laboratory) in 1997 and specialised in the analysis of pesticide and veterinary medicine residues in foods by liquid chromatography-mass spectrometry. In 2009, Mark moved to Fapas Proficiency Testing as the scientific advisor. This role involves supporting Fapas colleagues in operating proficiency tests to the highest technical standards, advising participant laboratories on interpretation of their assessments, and using proficiency test data to improve analytical chemistry. Mark works closely with all colleagues in Fapas and with senior scientists and directors in Fera to ensure that Fapas remains the most respected proficiency testing provider. Mark is an author or co-author on 36 peer reviewed scientific publications and regularly reviews manuscripts for analytical journals. He is a member of the Royal Society of Chemistry and represents Fapas and Fera at national and international meetings.
